### 1 IDENTIFIED LIGHTS

Have these pendant lights in the barn conversion by architect Seth Stein caught your eye? They are the 'Copper Shade', 45 x 41cm diameter, £285 each, from **Tom Dixon** (020-7183 9732; [www.tomdixon.net](http://www.tomdixon.net)).

### 2 DESIGN NOTE FLOORING

For the floor of the barn, Seth chose antique oak floorboards from **Ebony & Co** (020-7734 0734; [www.ebonyandco.com](http://www.ebonyandco.com)). Made from reclaimed trusses and beams from 200-year-old barns in New England, they are full of character. The boards, which are milled to order, are available in a range of widths, and cost from £253 a square metre.

### 3 SOURCE INLAID FURNITURE

For beautiful bone-inlaid furniture, using responsibly sourced camel bones, check out chic mail-order company **Niki Jones** (0141-959 4090; [www.niki-jones.co.uk](http://www.niki-jones.co.uk)). This three-drawer chest, which measures 85 x 90 x 45cm, and costs £1,495, looks similar to the one in the barn.

### 4 SPECIALIST SINK

**Sinks.co.uk** (01384-220030) stocks copper sinks and basins, including the 'Chateaux', 23.5 x 95 x 50cm, £1,362, which Seth used in the barn. The unusual bronze mixer tap is from the same source. It is the 'Picardie' by Perrin & Rowe, 27cm tall, which costs £437.
